



Students' Survey Results

1st Qualitative evaluation

The students directly involved in the mobility participated in our survey to tell us about their experience:






Due to Covid, the mobility in LITHUANIA did not take place physically, but only virtually.

Around 96-98% of the students felt comforted, found the host family friendly and helpful and were satisfied with the accommodation:

- I found the host family friendly and helpful. 46 risposte











I felt welcome when I arrived at the host family.

I am satisfied with the host accommodation.



Although between 2 and 4 % attested some difficulty in communication more with the hosting family than with the other students, the total number of participants state the mobility as a strongly positive experience. They improved social skills (100%)




I improved my social skills 46 risposte



They felt more self-confident since the exchange (100%)


- I have felt more self-confident since the exchange 46 risposte






97,8% consider the experience as a positive learning opportunity

- In the future, I would like to participate in an exchange again 46 risposte









In addition some remarks:


1) The survey gives the schools a positive feedback about the organization of the mobilities: 93,5% of the students were satisfied

2) The partnership has opened students' horizons about taking in account the possibility to work abroad in the future:





82,6% agree on this.
